Print preview – save to spreadsheet

All Cyberfreight reports can be saved to PDF, RTF (word processing) or spreadsheet file from the print preview screen. Use this feature if you want to adjust the standard report format.

WIP & Accrual Reports

It is advisable to run these reports on a regular basis, say weekly. These reports, especially the WIP report will identify any invoicing that may have been forgotten. It is very difficult to invoice a client many months after a job has been completed to best to invoice whilst the job is still active.

Mobile Device Applications

There is currently two Mobile Device applications for Cyberfreight. One is Mobile POD where the receiver signs on glass. The job is directly updated with the delivery date and a signed PDF of the delivery docket is saved in the job Doc Link folder and a copy emailed to your client. The second application, CargoTrack, enables your client to see the current location of their cargo on a map for the local delivery or pick up leg.

Auto Statements

Cyberfreight can be configured for auto statements. Statements can be automatically emailed to clients every month end, every Friday or whenever you choose. Once set up the statements are sent without any action on your part.

Multi Language Support

Cyberfreight version 4.02 onwards supports foreign languages. Optionally, a foreign language can be selected and then all screen labels will be in that

foreign language. Any foreign language can be supported in the future as we find translators for each language. Initially Simplified Chinese, Traditional Chinese and Japanese are available. Korean and Thai will follow soon.

Data Exchange

Cyberfreight can exchange data with all major logistics industry software packages. For example you could take the export manifest from your overseas agent as an electronic file and load it into Cyberfreight to create an import shipment. This will save you time and money plus reduce errors. Electronic data exchange make a lot of sense when data volumes are high (e.g commercial invoices, eCommerce manifests) and especially when time frames are short.

CyberTrack Web Portal

We have added new features to CyberTrack. Clients can download PDF copies of invoices, upload or download documents to/from the public area of a job Doc Link folder and clients can add /edit delivery address details for jobs.
