The Cyberfreight Marine Insurance interface is now in production. The module has been developed in conjunction with Coverfreight. Using normal data that you have already keyed into shipments a message is sent to Coverfreight and in a few seconds a marine insurance policy is returned as a PDF document into the job Doc Link folder. Quick, easy and you can earn income.

Cyberfreight road map

We are currently redeveloping Cyberfreight as a web/mobile application. Modules will be progressively converted one at a time so for an interim period both the current desktop and the new web/mobile versions will be running in parallel. Conversion of all modules should be completed by the end of 2018.
